- Total ADR reported till today(19/06/2023): 1548

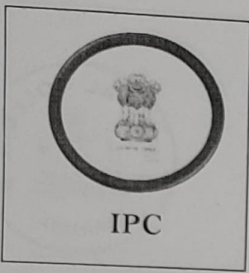
